

Hello.

October 4, 2015

Some time ago, I decided to join AVFM as what I believed to be the most suitable organization and vehicle for my advocacy endeavours.

On Monday, April 20, 2015, I had advised AVFM's management team that I would need to take a complete break after I awoke paralysed from the neck down. This was my second such episode and had been undergoing various tests at the hospital as I was clearly not well.

I came to realize, the massive load I was carrying helping others, being deeply involved in their cases of the most severe criminal type, my body had reached a point of breaking. I thought of my children and my elderly parents and made the difficult decision to 100% remove myself from the work I was doing, so I could heal and take care of my family.

I had committed to hosting the second annual 2015 TorontoDV Symposium including clearing up last year's debt by borrowing money against my assets. This would be my last activity in my advocacy work.

Unfortunately my scheduled closing for June 3, 2015 was not only delayed to July 6, 2015, it was 10s of thousands of dollars short. I was unable to clear up my bills not only for the 2014 TorontoDV Symposium, but now had further liability for the 2015 TorontoDV Symposium. I instructed my broker to raise additional funds which has recently materialized.

Fund raising was dismal despite several attempts to do so by varying strategies. I want to express my gratitude to Hanna Wallen, The Honey Badgers (Alison Tiaman, Karen Straughan) and Janet Bloomfield for their assistance in helping trying to raise money for the 2015 TorontoDV Symposium. The head of AVFM promised to help raise funds, but that failed to happen.

I had planned to very openly discuss with the AVFM management team of what I was dealing with, but the CEO informed me, these matters were not for everyone's ears. So I remained silent as asked of me. Furthermore, my last attempt to discuss this matter had been denied by the head of AVFM after agreeing to speak with me.

I am no longer willing to remain silent, particularly with the incredulously wanton threats made against me, by those who at a time, I thought were my friends and allies.

I have been accused of being a cheat, a liar, a thief, a con artist, dishonest in addition to being called a scum bag and coerced into doing things I was unable to do. Moreover, I have been threatened by a number of people to be publicly shamed, humiliated and thus excommunicated from the MRM for ever. This added stress has had a profoundly negative effect on my health, which deeply cruel, after I made it clear, that I was not well back in April.

In my risk estimation joining AVFM, I failed to assess the fact that those who could cover my back, could just as easily stab me in the back. I have seen this done to others and it was only a matter of time it would be done to me or to any other member of AVFM when the organization places you in their crosshair.

So I am going to be brutally honest. There are several issues that need to be addressed.

### **2015 TorontoDV Symposium:**

I made a decision to cancel the event due to lack of funds raised including ticket sales. Sen. Anne Cools was the first person I emailed and she was deeply disappointed. Another person who got wind of this at CAFÉ, said I could not and should not cancel this important event and promised to raise \$5,000.00 I needed. Based on that promise I went back on my decision, which I never do, and resurrected the event. This turned out to be only \$1,500.00 and my troubles began.

I informed head of AVFM staff of the situation, namely, that I was unable to pay for the \$6,500.00 cost to fly Erin Pizzey from the UK to Canada to speak at the 2014 TorontoDV Symposium. This also complicated matters as she was also scheduled to speak at the ICMI14 as well.

AVFM and Al Martin jointly covered and purchased the airline ticket for Erin while I promised to pay Al Martin \$1,700.00 and AVFM \$2,100.00 after some money was reduced for the plaque I made for Erin Pizzey. I purchased a first class ticket for Erin to travel from LA to Detroit to LA for \$1,383.20. Despite asking, I have yet to see a copy of the invoice for the flight AVFM arranged from London to Toronto to LA and eventually back to London.

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The cost for having Marty Fiebert and his wife travel to Toronto was agreed to be \$2,100.00 including lodging. This bill has not been covered and is being paid on Monday, October 5, 2015.

The cost of Erin Pizzey's hotel bill of about \$600 was covered by a friend who may not wish to be mentioned in this communication, but I would happy to do so if they agree to it. This person never once even mentioned this matter to me.

The cost of Stephan Moulineux's hotel \$450.00 bill was covered by him. He too will be reimbursed on Monday, October 5, 2015. Neither Stephan nor his assistant have never caused any fuss about this.

The total liability of the 2014 TorontoDV Symposium is slightly more than \$10,000.00 that I

have or will shortly cover the balance out of my personal funds.

The Canadian Maltese Charitable Service Trust's treasurer received numerous anonymous letters at our head office in Toronto, demanding to know why the CMCST would associate with such organizations as A Voice For Men and Canada Court Watch.

Lorris Herenda one of our scheduled presenters and CEO of the Yellow Brick House women's DV shelter, backed out of speaking at our event with less than 12 hours notice, when she found out the MRM would have a presence there. I later found out, recently, that the WRF of Toronto allegedly had much to do with that.

### **AVFM 1 Oz silver coins:**

After learning that the major contributor to AVFM's quarterly fund raising had reduced their last contribution to a mere \$1,000.00 and knowing of the growing need to find new revenue sources, I decided to produce tooling for the minting of AVFM 1oz coins.

I asked my father Peter who without hesitation agreed to spend the time to craft the plasticine model, hand engrave the dies and build the production minting dies. He also created a die to produce minted bottle openers. This was to be well advertised on AVFM to debut at the ICMI14. Due to the security difficulties we endured, having to move the venue, this did not happen and had a negative effect on sales.

It was my belief based on over 30 years of creating coins and never having sales of less than \$10,000.00 on any product we created, that 100 coins would easily sell among the MRM. As such, I felt confident to manufacture 100 1 oz silver coins in advance. At the time I did not have the capital to purchase 150 ounces of silver, needed to melt into ingots, roll into sheet and create blanks. I asked Al Martin who agreed to loan me the \$3,400 of the \$3,600 I needed to purchase silver at \$24.00 per oz to get this job done.

The cost of the work my father donated is at about \$8,000.00.

Having moved goods between the US and Canada many, many times, my gut told me I should not carry more than say 30 coins between the US Canada border. As it turned out, the US Border Officer, for reasons unknown to me, did ask if I was bringing coins into the USA. I truthfully told him that I did have some coins, explained what I was doing, where I was going and after lengthy questioning, I was allowed to enter into the US on my way to St. Claire Shores, ICMI14.

Regrettably, sales of this coin have been at a dismal 23 pieces and the bottle openers were not even introduced to market. It is the first and only time I have experienced such a thing. Having

AVFM adversaries attack the integrity of this coin did not help. My father, our firm and myself were humiliated publicly. I was instructed by the head of AVFM not to defend myself, my father or my business and if I continued on my path to out my adversaries that I should “take a vacation from AVFM.” This grossly violated my policy of vehemently defending the integrity of my family name, my family and my business.

The sales of 23 pieces at just under \$60.00 totalling \$1,380.00 does not even come close to covering my out of pocket expenses.

I have been asked why I did not at least return the silver and accused of keeping it for myself. Unfortunately, in it's current state it has zero value to me. I can't sell it and would need to melt it, turn it into ingots, roll it and create new blanks for some other project. Furthermore, the current price of silver is more than \$10.00 less per oz that what I purchase it for. I am stuck with absorbing that loss. I borrowed money, not silver. However, to show, that I have not benefited one single bit, I am shipping out the 100 coins and 100 certificates to AVFM for their disposition that I have kept in inventory for over one year.

### **2015 TorontoDV Symposium**

Dr. Tanveer Ahmed agreed to be the keynote speaker at the 2015 TorontoDV Symposium. I secured his flight at a cost of \$1,500.00, economy fair. He asked me if he could book the flight on Qantas where he enjoys certain perks for frequent flying. This elevated the cost to \$3,500.00, but I felt his presence would easily draw a sound audience covering the added cost. This was a gross error as his presence did not sell a single ticket nor did the MSM publish any of his articles. The cost of his hotel bill was at \$600.00. I picked him up at the airport on Thursday and dropped him off at the hotel. He got himself checked in. I had planned to pay him \$3,500 on Friday and the \$600.00 hotel bill. Tanveer has been paid \$3,600.00. There has been some banking issue with my recent \$3,000.00 payment that will be cleared up. Given his actual threats against me, I have been forced to deal with him in manner that will protect me against harm. More importantly the harm it would inflict against my children. I am sure he will give some of you my correspondence, as he has been doing.

The cost of flying Paul Elam to Toronto was \$800.00, but he asked me to fly him business class as he does not do well in small seating due to his frame. The only option next to economy is first class on domestic continental flights between Toronto and Houston. The cost of that ticket was instead \$1,378.26. After picking Paul up at the airport, I drove him to the hotel where I prepaid his bill of about \$600.00. He told me he only had enough room on his credit card to pay for food and wanted my assurance that the hotel would not charge him for his stay. I in his presence used my debit card to pay his hotel bill.

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The hotel attempted to charge my Visa card for about \$1,000.00 several times causing it to be locked. I had no means and time to deal with that issue.

I had agreed to cover the hotel cost of Suzy McCarley and Dean Esmay as my home was under renovations and could not have any guests. Nearing the event and hoping ticket sales would ignite once we announced Paul would be speaking at Ryerson, the shock of virtually no sales became clear. I found myself in a difficult situation and asked Paul's help to do a fund raiser on AVFM prior to him leaving for Toronto. I really did not want to do this, but was in desperate need to cover expenses.

Oddly, even after providing AVFM with 10 free tickets, not one AVFM person came to see him, not even protesters.

Funding that I was raising had met a number of impediments with an eventual fund date of June 3, 2015. The first day of our event and my absolute backup plan to cover last year's expenses and that of this year. Paul said he needed to clear this my fund raising request with C-level management, but did not see any issue with doing so. He also told me he could only do it after he returned to Houston. This never happened.

I had kept Suzy up to speed about my situation and asked her, before she left if she could help out with \$1,000.00 on an emergency basis if needed. She said she could do that if I needed it. When Suzy and Dean arrived I was unable to cover their hotel bill as I was waiting for PayPal to deposit money into my bank account which takes 3-5 business days and my Visa card was locked. I assured the hotel on Friday, that I would cover their bill either by cash or by debit card that day. I also asked Dean, Suzy and Paul if Paul and Dean could share a room to save on costs. It turned out that Paul got his own room while Dean and Suzy shared a room.

My law firm informed me Friday morning that there were complications and closing was not going to take place Friday June, 3, 2015 as expected. I thought perhaps a day or two delay, which turned out to be 4 long weeks and tens of thousands of dollars short. I asked Suzy to help out with that \$1,000.00. She said she could not cover both the hotel bill and dinner, which is what I had planned to use the money for (dinner). She also begged me not to let Paul or Dean know she was going to help me with money. I told Suzy that I felt uncomfortable keeping any secrets from Paul or Dean and that I would rather cancel dinner at the Old Mill where I had reservations. She insisted to not cancel dinner and that she would secretly cover the bill.

After the Friday's venue of the 2015 TorontoDV symposium, driving my father and children home, I began to feel extremely ill to the point I was having difficulty driving. Earlier that day, I could not even have lunch as I was not feeling well. I made a decision that there was no way I could or should return to have dinner with everyone. I later found out some people noted that I got conveniently sick as if to avoid being there. I did manage to get to the bank and get the cash

needed to cover the hotel bill of Suzy and Dean. The last thing I did Friday night was to contact the hotel that on Saturday they would be paid. Earlier, I contacted Vernon Beck as I was unsure I would be able to manage the Saturday part of the Symposium which he agreed to emcee if need be.

Saturday morning I woke up after falling asleep in my chair the night before. I felt well enough to head down to the Saturday venue and press on with the event. I had the cash in my pocket ready to give it to Suzy. However to my further shock, I was informed by third party that Paul, Suzy and Dean had left Toronto. I called the hotel and they told me they had checked out and they used the credit of Paul's room to cover what was owing on Suzy and Dean's room. I managed to have hotel staff reach Suzy, but she told me I should not speak with Paul and did not explain exactly why. Nobody bothered to offer any help instead drove to Detroit incurring a \$300.00 cost to change flight from Toronto to Detroit.

Tanveer Ahmed arrived and he told me what had happened. We had a quick meeting, I explained exactly what my situation was and we agreed to move on with the event without Paul speaking on Saturday, despite the fact I paid for his hotel bill and his first class flight to Toronto.

### **Director of Activism**

During my time with AVFM I have been to Ohio in support of Nicholas Alahverdian with my boys. Been present at nearly every management meeting. Worked on the ICMI14 planning committee. Emceed the ICMI14 on short notice. Brought my father and children with me to support the event. Drove people to and from the airport in Detroit. Went to Hamilton protesting the protesters of Bill Cosby. Went to Ottawa several times to do postering and to support Prof. Fiamengo. Been to Queen's university to document the Jaclyn Friedman event. Went back to Kingston several more times to do postering and meet with police. Been to Bracebridge Courthouse a number of times in the case of Bill Mullins including purchasing court transcripts and files for about \$150.00. Also went to Bracebridge Courthouse to assist wrongfully convicted E.P. who is behind bars now about three years. Been to Kingston in support of C.K. who at the age of 24 has been wrongfully sentenced to jail. He is also a victim of being raped by guards and inmates in jail. Been to Peterborough several times working and documenting the S.C. wrongful child porn conviction case which appears to have succeeded in obtaining leave to appeal in appellate court, Toronto. This is nearly unprecedented. He has recently been stabbed three times and recovering in hospital now. Translated all of the AVFM main-site into Hungarian. My father located four professional Hungarian journalists who would have been writing for AVFM Magyarorszag.

While others have received money from AVFM including remuneration, my department has been afforded not a single dime of the money that AVFM collects. Leaving me out of pocket for several thousand dollars.

Furthermore, I have found out that due to my association with AVFM, I have lost a \$90,000.00 contract with PWGSC and DND, January 2014. Prior to that, before joining AVFM, I lost \$2,000,000.00 in contracts in 2011, due to my involvement within the MRM. This is all public record, you can look it up.

### **Closing remarks.**

To call me a con artist and to embark on a path to knowingly, and willingly cause me, my family and particularly my children harm by cyber attacking me is criminally malicious. Those who still think I am a liar and dishonest should know, everything I have said, remarked and my entire interaction with AVFM has been digitally recorded. In my defence, I will not hesitate to make that public should the need arise to do so. Remember before you hit the publish button, in a battle both parties are injured. The one who is injured less is wrongly perceived to be the victor. I hope we can avert such a calamity which would not bode well for anyone and certainly not the MRM. The infighting MUST stop!

If I am a con artist, I fail to comprehend that advantage I have gained. I think the absolute opposite is true.

I did not sign up for this kind of abuse including already having my home being stalked by dangerous feminists accurately describing the inside of my home on the net. My children being the targets of abuse on the net by enemies of AVFM. Or the threats of lawsuits by lawyers for exposing feminists and their lawyers.

I don't believe this was intentional, but a letter I wrote to the Town of Collingwood, AVFM republished, failed to realize they were publicizing my home address. In another instance, without my consent, private communication was made public by senior AVFM staff which resulted in the deterioration of my relations with other groups and people.

Management is wondering why readership at AVFM is down. Its like this. People will slow down and take a look at a crash on the side of the road. The bigger the crash the more they will stop and look. After a while it becomes boring. This is the chasm AVFM is in. It will either fall back to where it began. cross it and move to a higher elevation or fall into the chasm and self destruct. Again, I will strongly urge management to develop a solid business plan with short, mid and long term goals. This will enable it to seek funding either publicly or privately as a business. How many people/volunteers will AVFM grind up, before it realizes, it must pay their staff?

Paul told me he would fly my father and I to the next ICMI event to ensure we were comfortable. Instead I got insulted with, if you volunteer in October, you will get a free pass with a value of \$600.00, but your dad and kids will need to pay to get in. Moments after that I was ready to submit my resignation. Suzy talked me out of it.

I wanted to thank Suzy for her ear and the hard work she does at AVFM. I wanted to thank AVFM for giving me \$300.00 when I was seriously stuck for cash. I returned that money a short time later. I wanted to thank all those who put money together when I asked to help a fellow AVFM staff member who was about to be evicted from their home. My contribution was \$200.00, at the time representing all the cash I had. Since then, recently, it came to my attention that an AVFM member was on the verge of eviction. I offered to help, but then realized the ramifications it would have, should others find out I did so. I also want to thank David King for helping me with various computer issues as did Dean Esmay.

It was a distinct pleasure working with many people at AVFM. In the end I had my teeth kicked in when I was down with my plea for help, fully ignored. Thank you for doing your best to help.

It has come to my attention that AVFM CEO and Dr. Tanveer Ahmed are possibly conspiring to destroy my reputation publicly. Is this what AVFM is about? Does this stand for due process it profoundly says it protects? I attempted to deal with this at the highest level privately, but was instead silenced by it.

I will never return to the MRM or the cult that has without thought or consideration thrown me under the wheels of the bus. Will deal with my obligations and never look back on this treacherous dark moment and happily return to my business and executive life to enjoy my time with my family and children.
